Basics About 4-H

- 4-H is a non-formal educational, youth development program offered to individuals age 5 and in kindergarten up to age 19. Youth are involved in hands-on, experiential learning that allows learning by doing. All 4-H programs focus on active involvement and quality experiences which stimulate lifelong learning of values and skills.
- 4-H membership is divided into two age-appropriate groups. The Cloverbud program is for youth age 5 and in kindergarten through second grade. The traditional 4-H program is for youth age 8 and in the third grade through the calendar year a youth reaches age 19.
- Youth in 4-H “learn by doing” as they participate in more than 200 projects and hundreds of other activities designed to help them develop as individuals and become responsible, productive members of society.
- 4-H membership begins when an eligible individual is enrolled in a club or group that is under direction of a qualified, trained adult and within the scope of The Ohio State University Extension.
- The expectations for traditional 4-H membership are a balance between 4-H project work, involvement in the 4-H club, participation in 4-H activities and events, and working towards improving one’s personal growth.
