As a 4-H Teen Ambassador, you will be required to participate in monthly meetings at the OSU Extension office at 5:00pm on the first Thursday of each month and attend the Belmont County 4-H Council meetings at 6:00pm on the first Thursday of every other month.

Meetings will consist of the planning and implementation and assisting with various countywide 4-H events and opportunities. This will include but is not limited to 4-H promotions, community service projects, project judging, and other planned activities.

Each year, the group will set goals to achieve in promoting the 4-H program to the greater community through planned activities.

We will select up to 15 Teen Ambassadors each year. Please encourage your 4-H friends to apply!

Paper applications are due to the OSU Extension Office by November 1st, 2024. Selections will be made, and applicants will be notified by email to attend the kick of meeting at 5:00pm at the OSU Extension Office on November 20th, 2024.
