# Livestock & Jr. Fair Information

## Reminder - NEW Drug Use Notification Form (DUNF) Procedure

It is time to get your DUNFs done!

Starting this year, the State is requiring all Drug Use Notification Forms (DUNFs) be completed and submitted online. Paper forms will no longer be accepted. On Tuesday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, all Jr. Fair 4-H livestock exhibitors were emailed a DUNF survey to their family email address through the 4-H Online system. County FFA advisors also shared the link and it was posted on the Belmont County 4-H Facebook page. If you have not submitted your form(s) yet, we ask that you do so as soon as possible to give us time to review each one prior to weigh-ins. Exhibitors and their parent/guardian will be required to sign off on the form when submitting.

A DUNF must be completed for every Jr. Fair market animal and lactating dairy cow and lactating dairy goat, and egg production chicken prior to weigh-in and showing at the county fair. Animals will not be weighed without a completed DUNF submission.

**GROOMING RULES:** From page 58 of the Fair Tab under General Livestock Rules: All clipping, grooming, and shearing must be done prior to animal's arrival at the fairgrounds. No artificial color, adhesive, enhancers, etc. may be used in preparing market animals for the fair. Market animals should be washed and brushed only. NO sleeves, blankets, ice packs, ice, wet towels and drenching is permitted. If anyone is found guilty of this offense, he/she will be penalized by being ineligible to show (including showmanship) and sell that species of animal the present year and will be ineligible to bring any animal to the fair the following year. 4-H/FFA members preparing for Breeding Classes will not be restricted from grooming or clipping their animals. It is required that the member be present and actively participating in preparing project animal(s) they are going to show. For clarification, see specific rules that pertain to your species. (from page 56 of Belmont County Fair Tab under General Livestock Rules)

**WEIGH-INS:** All Jr. Fair market animals, excluding poultry and rabbits, must be in place by 8:00a.m. on Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>. Hog weigh-in begins at 8:00a.m., followed by sheep, goats, steers, then feeder calves. All other Jr. Fair animals must be in place by 7:00p.m., Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>. Rabbit weigh-in begins at 7:30p.m., immediately followed by poultry weigh-in.

**LIVESTOCK SALE RULES:** Market exhibitors with an animal going through the livestock sale must let the Sale Committee know of their animals being sold by the conclusion of the Swine Show Wednesday night. Animals will not go through the sale if it is not reported to the committee. NEW FOR 2022, there is a new system for reporting "Will Sell" animals. Exhibitors must pick up their "Will Sell" card from the Jr. Fair office and complete, sign, and return it to the Junior Fair office by Wednesday night after the hog show. We will no longer accept a name written on a list at the office window. If you do not turn your "Will Sell" card back into the office, your animal will not be on the sale bill and will not be sold.

## Outstanding Livestock Project Exhibitor Award

Again this year, there will be a Most Outstanding Exhibitor Award for each livestock species: Beef, Dairy, Sheep, Goats, Swine, Horses, Poultry and Rabbits. Winners will be determined based on their Skill-a-thon score, showmanship placing and live placing scores. A belt buckle award will be presented to the winner of each species at the conclusion of the Showman of Showmen contest on Saturday, September 10<sup>th</sup> at 2:00.

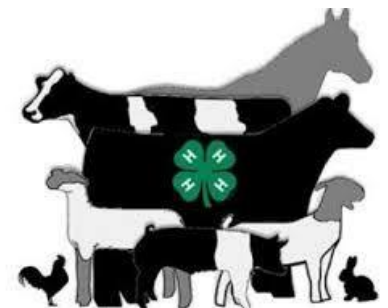

## FAIR BOOTHS

Club exhibits must be in place by Noon on Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>. The Jr. Fair Building will be open for booth set up and decorating:  
September 4<sup>th</sup> – 10:00am-5:00pm  
September 5<sup>th</sup> – 10:00am-Noon

Exhibits must remain in place until Sunday, September 11<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm in order to receive booth and individual premiums. All booths must be torn down by 6:30pm on Sunday. All materials, including staples, must be removed. A Jr. Fair Department Advisor must check your booth and approve it before you leave for premiums to be awarded. Premiums will be mailed out to club advisors after fair.

## CLOVERBUD NEWS

All Cloverbud fair exhibits will be displayed in a county-wide Cloverbud booth in the Jr. Fair Booth Building. All Cloverbuds are to bring one craft or item they made with their club to display in the county booth. Exhibits may be brought during booth decorating hours.



## Award and Trophy Winners

All trophy/award winners are required to write a Thank You note to their award sponsor during fair week before collecting their award. Thank You notes are provided at the Jr. Fair office, located behind the Livestock Show Arena. These are available for all still project and livestock awards. Still Project Trophies, Outstanding Project Knowledge award t-shirts and First Place Still Project award t-shirts can be picked up after the awards ceremony and during fair week at the Jr. Fair office upon completion of the Thank You note. Livestock awards are awarded at the livestock shows but are returned to the Jr. Fair display in the Livestock Show Arena. These awards will be released on Saturday at 8:30a.m., provided the thank you note has been completed. Congratulations to all of you! Great job!

### Jr. Fair Board Applications

Teens, 13 to 19 years of age as of January 1, 2023, who are interested in serving on the 2023 Jr. Fair Board should complete a Jr. Fair Board application and return it to the Extension office by 4:30pm on October 1, 2022. Applications will be available September 1st and can be picked up at the Extension office or at the Jr. Fair office during the fair. Jr. Fair Board director terms will run from November 2022 to October 2023.
